## 1 NATURAL PAINTS, from £28.79 per 5ltr emulsion, Womersleys

'I love these paints - the sample cards come with the colours painted on, so I can really see what the colours look like. The range echoes nature - they are colours you see in a field or garden. My bedroom has a cream-painted ceiling and Lute walls.'

#### 2 JOSEPH JOSEPH CHOP2POT CHOPPING BOARD, £9.99, Drinkstuff.com

'This great design makes slicing onions and garlic and popping them into the pan easier, as the sides of the board fold into a chute to guide ingredients into the pot.'

# 3 BIOPOWER 93 SPORT WAGON, around £24,000, Saab (www. saabbiopower.co.uk)
